Changes to Train Times

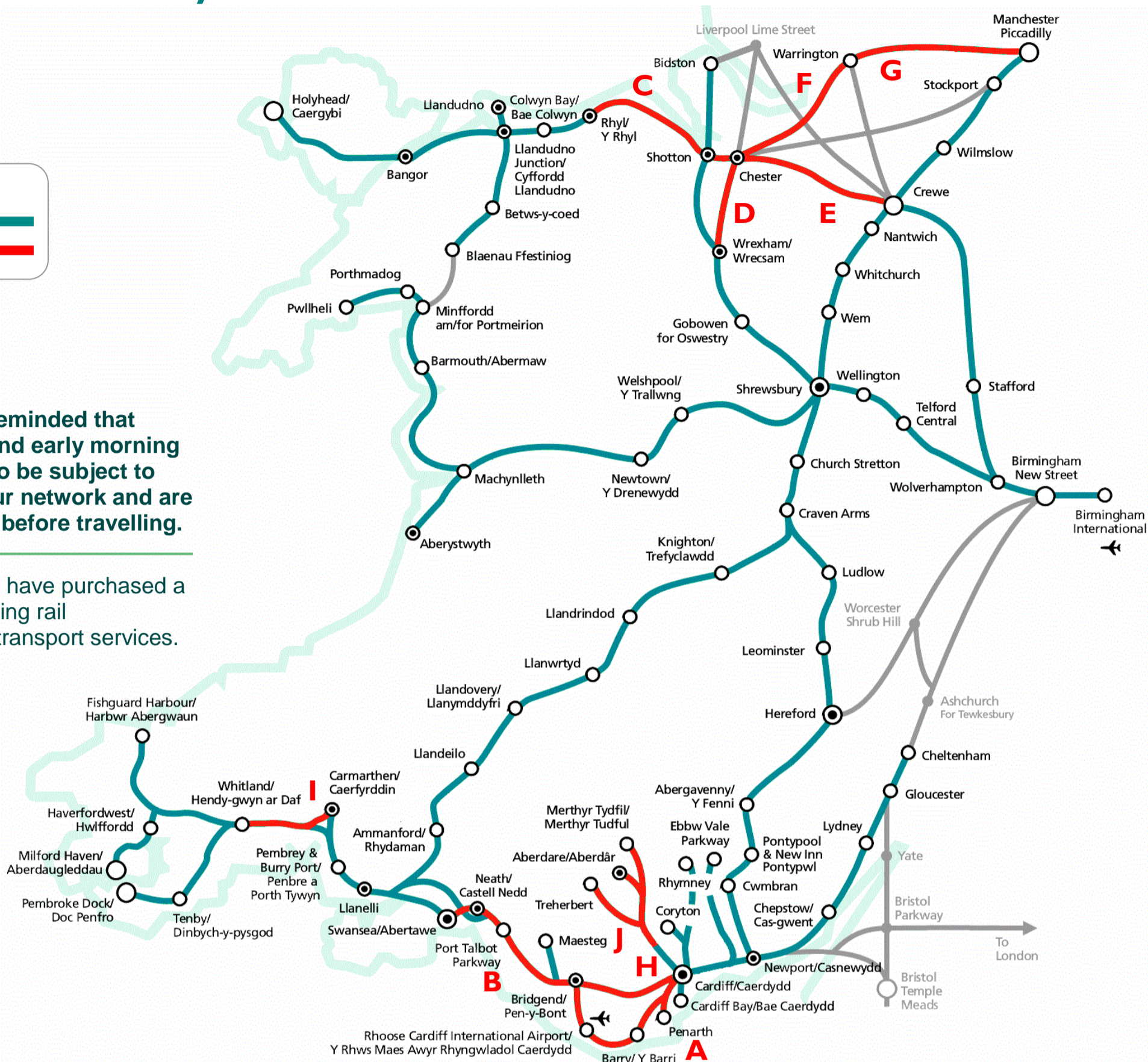

Major engineering work will be taking place during February on the Arriva Trains Wales network at the locations detailed below and this will result in changes to the published timetable. A Cardiff Central to Barry Island / Bridgend via VoG / Penarth

Sundays 5th, 19th and 26th February until 1300

On the above dates trains between Cardiff Central and Barry Island / Bridgend via VoG / Penarth will be replaced with road transport throughout serving all stations in both directions until 1300.

B Cardiff Central to Swansea

Sunday 5th February

On the above date trains between Cardiff Central and Swansea / West Wales will be replaced with road transport between Cardiff Central and Swansea serving all stations via Port Talbot Parkway in both directions.

C Chester to Rhyl

Sunday 5th February

On the above date trains between Chester and Holyhead will be replaced with road transport between Chester and Rhyl serving all stations via Shotton in both directions.

D Chester to Wrexham General

Sunday 5th February

On the above date trains between Chester and Birmingham International via Shrewsbury will be replaced with road transport between Chester and Wrexham General in both directions.

E Chester to Crewe

Saturdays 11th and 18th February from 2100

Sundays 12th and 19th February until 1300

On the above dates trains between North Wales / Chester and Crewe will be replaced with road transport between Chester and Crewe in both directions.

F Chester to Warrington Bank Quay

Saturdays 11th and 18th February from 2100

Sunday 12th February until 1300

On the above dates trains between Holyhead / Llandudno / Chester and Manchester Piccadilly will be unable to serve intermediate stations via Frodsham with trains being diverted between Chester and Warrington Bank Quay via an alternative route. Road transport will operate serving Helsby, Frodsham, and Runcorn East in both directions.

G Chester to Manchester Piccadilly via Warrington Bank Quay

Sundays 19th and 26th February

On the above dates trains between Holyhead / Llandudno / Chester and Manchester Piccadilly will be unable to serve intermediate stations via Warrington Bank Quay with trains being diverted between Chester and Manchester Piccadilly via an alternative route. Road transport will operate serving Helsby, Frodsham, Runcorn East, Warrington Bank Quay, Earlestown, Newton le Willows and Manchester Oxford Road in both directions.

H Cardiff Queen Street to Cardiff Central / Grangetown

Sunday 19th February from 1300

On the above date trains between Cardiff Queen Street and Cardiff Central / Grangetown will be replaced with road transport in both directions from 1300.

I Carmarthen to Whitland

Sunday 26th February

On the above date trains between Swansea and Fishguard Harbour / Milford Haven / Pembroke Dock will be replaced with road transport between Carmarthen and Whitland in both directions.

J Radyr to Aberdare / Merthyr Tydfil / Treherbert

Sunday 26th February until 1330

On the above dates train services between Cardiff Central and Aberdare / Merthyr Tydfil / Treherbert will be replaced with road transport between Radyr and Aberdare / Merthyr Tydfil / Treherbert serving all stations via Pontypridd until 1330.
